#### Task Manager

New task manager system now available from the Main Menu. This allows you to assign tasks to any SACS user.

### **Recoupment Processing**

Recoup payments can now be automatically processed. The system will determine the correct amount to deduct from the owner's check.

#### **Tenant Services**

The Tenant Security module has been renamed to Tenant Services. The new Case Management module is now available. This module allows you to maintain goals, services, and agencies. Contact SACS Sales for more details on this new module.

### **Development Map**

Added a Development Map for Section 8

Added the ability to geocode apartments in Conventional Housing and Section 8. Geocoding populates the unit's latitude and longitude fields.

#### **Web Applications**

# Developer's Corner

The latest release of SACS Housing Software contains a number of enhancements. Tenant Security has been renamed to Tenant Services. Tenant Services now includes our new Case Management system.

Case Management can be used for FSS, ROSS or any other program. It allows agencies to easily establish goals and track FSS plans. ROSS services can be tracked also. The system produces the HUD-52650 form, Follow Up Report, and Services Summary. This system is now being beta tested and will soon be available. For more information, contact SACS Sales.

Section 8 users will now find it easier to recoup payments from owners. The Section 8 system now allows you to enter recoupment information for automatic processing during the next check run. These enhancements make

it easier to track and account for owner recoupment.

HUD has now mandated that flat rents be set to a minimum of 80% of fair market rent. You are also required to update your flat rents annually based on the published fair market rent. Due to the increase in flat rent, some agencies will be required to phase in their increases over a three year period. The maximum increase is 35% per year.

We are now preparing for the 2015 SACS User Conference. Our new Tenant Manager will be demonstrated at the conference. This exciting enhancement is now being tested by our beta users. Look for more exciting information about SACS Software and our conference in the coming months.

# Tech Tips

Managing user access in SACS
Housing Software is an important task.
With each update, we add new features
that often include new programs.
These new programs are not added to
any user's profile by default.

When you install a new software release, review the Release Notes for items that start with "Added". These items generally indicate that a new program has been added to the system. The Search option in Adobe reader will help you quickly find these items.

In order to grant user access and permissions, you will need access to System Administration. Employees acting as the system administrator should already have access to this module. The *User Setup* option is used to setup new users, grant access to specific programs, and limit a user's permissions.

When you have granted an employee access to a program, you can also set their permission level. For example, you may give a user access to the *Tenants* program, but limit their permission to *Inquiry*.

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# Announcement - SACS Classic

Since 1987, SACS Housing Software has made managing Public Housing and Section 8 easier. Our SACS Classic software was a mainstay for agencies that were transitioning from manual to automated systems.

SACS Classic served our customers well. The system was solid and ran on Unix, DOS, and Windows platforms. As personal computers moved to the Windows operating system, customers started asking for a graphical based accounting system.

We listened to our customers. In 2003 we began development work on a new project named SACS. Net. Using SACS Classic as a pattern, our developers spent several years reengineering all of our programs using the new Microsoft .Net development system.

From 2007 to 2014, we upgraded our customers from our original software to SACS.Net. We are proud to announce



that all of our customers have been upgraded to SACS.Net. Going forward, we will now refer to our software as SACS Housing Software.

SACS Classic is hard for us to let go – it worked for well over seven years with no updates to the base code. We now, however, must say farewell and remember the twenty-seven years that it served us.
