Build 6533 Highlights

SACS Software Build 6533 was released on 11/20/17. Listed below are some highlights from this release.

After installing this update, you can view the full release notes from the SACS Main Menu by clicking Help then Release Notes.

Accounts Receivable

Deposits can be processed for a different posting sequence.

Data/Applications

Added the ability to print the HUD-9887 form.

Payroll

Updated the 1094 and 1095 forms for tax year 2017.

Added a new report to print employee birthdays.

Web Application

Added the ability for applicants to change their contact information.

Added the ability to accept credit card payments online.

Direct Debits/Deposits

The employee, vendor, and tenants direct debit/deposit screens now show the bank name associated with the routing number.

Developer's Corner

Many of you have noticed the new SACS icon, as shown below. After many years of service, we decided to retire our original icon. The new icon was designed by our in-house graphic artists. It brings a fresh new look to our applications. It will be phased in during the next year.

There have been over 240 changes in the past two updates. We encourage you to read the release notes available with each update. Many of the changes are minor refinements to the software; while other changes add new features to the system.

With each update, we refresh the F1 help with the changes to our applications. We also update the online manuals found on the SACS Software website. If you have a question about how a field needs to be filled or how a report works, the F1 help is a key press away.

The IRS made slight changes to the 2017 tax forms. All customers will need to install Build 6533 for these changes.

W2, 1099, and 1095 forms should be distributed to employees, owners, and vendors by January 31, 2018. W2 and 1099 forms will also need to be submitted by paper or electronically

by January 31, 2018. 1094 and 1095 forms should be submitted to the IRS by February 28, 2018.

The tax tables for 2018 have not been released. Changes in the tax law have caused a delay in releasing the tax tables. We will send a SACS News Flash when they are available.

We are now working on the changes for TRACS 203A. There are a number of new fields being added to track additional information on residents. We will be testing these changes during the first quarter of 2018.

HUD is still working on PIC-NG. As of our last discussion, they are looking at the Fall of 2018.

Tech Tips

Utility consumption can easily be tracked in SACS Housing Software. This can be helpful in the completion of your Performance Funding System (PFS) calculation submission.

To set up the parameters, navigate to the Setup folder in the Accounts Payable module. In the Utility Consumption setup screen add each project where you are tracking utility consumption.

When entering an invoice, click the Utility button to open the Utility Consumption screen. Select the month and fiscal year of the invoice. Once the invoice has been selected for payment, the Utility Consumption History is updated.
