Build 5154 Highlights

SACS Software Build 5154 was released on 2/10/14. Listed below are some highlights from this release.

Tenant Accommodations

An Accommodation tab was added to the Tenants screen in the Tenant Receivables module. This feature allows you to add accommodation requests.

Payables Direct Deposit

Direct Deposits are now available in the Accounts Payable module. This allows you to set up your vendors to receive payment by direct deposit.

Document Manager

The Document Manager module now supports the ability to set a print option for each program. For example, during a reexamination, you can have the 50058 archive to the Document Manager only, without a paper copy printing.

Electronic Signing

Electronic Signing is now available for the Lease, Application for Admission, and the Application for Continued Occupancy. With this feature, all of these programs can be electronically signed with a signing pad. The only copy that prints is the electronically signed tenant copy.

Developer's Corner

The evolution of software applications includes the dynamic relationship between developer and consumer. Your SACS developers recognize your value in this process and listen carefully. We are preparing a number of exciting enhancements to our software applications.

We have talked about contract management for a number of years. The initial development has been completed and our Contract Management system is now moving into beta testing. This system not only allows you to manage contracts, but also supports bid management as well.

The new Contract Management system will allow you to track vital information on bids. When the bid is awarded, the bid can be imported into a contract for further management. A complete list of features and capabilities will be announced after beta testing is completed.

Two new applications have been released for our tablet platform. Occupants Inquiry and Excess Utilities are now available for the tablet. Our Inventory application is currently in development. If you are already using a tablet, these applications will definitely improve your productivity.

The Occupants Inquiry tablet application and our Occupants Inquiry web application have been popular



with agency security personnel and police departments.

Our next software release will include a new task management productivity tool. This application will allow you to create tasks for work to be completed. Tasks can be entered for yourself or other employees. It features email notification of assigned and completed tasks. This is another tool to help improve your efficiency.

We continue to work on our new notification system. The next software release will have the ability to email or send short messages to tenants when work orders are issued and/or completed. These simple features are easy to implement and improves your communication with your residents.

You can print a deposit slip from Tenant Receivables. The *Make Deposit* program is located in the End of Day folder. This program can print a slip to take to the bank instead of having to hand write all the transactions. This program also creates the deposit in the Cash Management system.

Tech Tips

We have received a number of calls regarding computer security. Recent security breaches reported by the media has heightened the awareness of protecting your network and data.

You can protect your network and data by keeping your computer updated with Windows Security Updates, making sure that your anti-virus software's subscription is current, and requiring complex passwords.

When we install a new computer, it is set up to automatically download Security Updates. These are generally issued once per month. We set up the computers to download these and automatically reboot. If you see a message that security updates are available, go ahead and install the updates and reboot the computer when they have completed.

Because hackers are relentless, you should require everyone to use complex passwords. A complex password includes upper and lower case characters, numbers and punctuation marks. We require that our employees change their passwords every 180 days. This option can be configured in windows so that employees are automatically prompted to change their passwords.

Anti-virus software should be installed on every computer connected to your network. This includes laptops and



If you access your network remotely, use a firewall with a VPN tunnel. A VPN tunnel has two sets of passwords to access your network. The tunnel password is setup on the local network and remote machine. The second password is the user name and assigned password. This makes it extremely difficult for hackers to gain access to your network. A VPN tunnel also encrypts your data so that it cannot be viewed by anyone outside your network.

Our SACS Network is secured by a firewall. It is amazing to see how many times people from other countries try to access our network. Again remember hackers are relentless, so we must be diligent in securing our network and data.

The most valuable item stored on your computer is your data. A virus or hacker that gains access to your computer can easily destroy that data. We have worked with one customer that had a virus destroy all of their databases. It also destroyed all of the backups stored on their server. The importance of keeping an external backup cannot be over emphasied. Always backup your data to an external device.

This announcement means that Microsoft will no longer provide support or security updates for Windows XP. If you have computers running Windows XP, you should take action now to upgrade those computers. Without security updates, they present a security risk to your agency.
