#### **SACS Notifier**

The SACS Notifier is an automated system for sending email and texting messages (SMS) to your residents.

This system can send reexamination appointment reminders, rent due reminders, and issued and completed work order messages.

It includes a mass notification option. This option will allow you to send an email or text message to all residents.

Reminder notifications can be sent one or more days before a scheduled event. They can event be sent multiple times.

This is a reminder of your recertification appointment with SACS Housing Authority on Wednesday, 3/8/2017 at 1:15 PM.

The messages can be setup with your agency's specific wording and requirements.

SACS Notifier uses a SMS gateway to quickly route messages to resident phones regardless of the provider.

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### **Build 6295 Highlights**

SACS Software Build 6295 was released on 3/28/17. Listed below are some highlights from this release.

After installing this update, you can view the full release notes from the SACS Main Menu by clicking Help then Release Notes.

### System Setup

A new program in the System Administration menu allows users to access system setup.

### **Rent/HAP Register**

The Tenant Receivable module now has a report that will list the tenant's rent and HAP amount. This can be used by agencies that receive HAP subsidies for tenants. This will help agencies with RAD PBV.

#### **Mass Change Caseworker**

A new program for the Conventional and Section 8 modules to change caseworkers in mass. This allows agencies to quickly assign and distribute residents to case workers.

# Mass Change Application Status

A new feature has been added to the Mass Change Application Status program. You can easily change a specific number of applicants from one status to another based selection criteria.

#### 2017 941 Form

The new 2017 Form is included in this update.

#### Menu Theme

The color of the menu can now be changed using built-in themes.

# Developer's Corner

At the 2017 User Conference, we presented a demonstration of our new mobile applications for Android and Apple devices. The SACS Occupant Inquiry is now being tested.

Our goal is to make all of our Windows mobile applications available on the Android and Apple platforms this year. We will be making announcements when they become available.

A representative from HUD REAC attended the conference and informed users about PIC-NG. PIC-NG will replace the current PIC system. The new system should be available during the first quarter of 2017. We will start beta testing this summer.

TRACS has announced the release of TRACS 203A. This version brings new reporting and data capturing requirements. We will be addressing the new requirements in an upcoming software release. TRACS will begin accepting 203A transactions in June.

The current software release includes changes for flat rent calculations for prorated assistance. Some customers have flat rents that are adjusted for tenant paid utility. This required us to have two setup fields for flat rent. One that contains the actual flat rent and one that has the flat rent that is adjusted for tenant paid utilities. See PIH Notice 2012-14 for more information.

The new SACS Notifier brings automated email and SMS (text messaging) to your residents. This system will automatically send appointment reminders, rent due reminders, and work order issued and completed messages. See the front page sidebar for more information.

Menu theming is included in the current software release. This gives you the ability to set the color of your menu.

We have several exciting changes planned for this year. These along with HUD mandated changes will keep us busy.

# Tech Tips

The VMS Data report can be a big help for Section 8 authorities. It provides a summary of information needed to complete the 52681-B form.

For this report to present correct information, it is important that you enter payment adjustments for each month. You cannot lump several months of payments into one month.

The report can print out detailed information to help you analyze the reported information.

Date based utility allowances for Conventional Housing and Section 8 have been a great enhancement. This allows agencies to enter new allowances before they become effective. Our applications will automatically select the correct allowance based on the effective date.

For Section 8, these allowances will allow you to print the HUD-52667 form. For more information contact SACS Technical Support.

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# Report Scheduler

The SACS Report Scheduler is used to email an employee or group of employees report information from your SACS database. The reporting service is automatic and can be configured to send information based on your criteria.

The following is an example of a report that lists the members that are turning 18 this month.

## Letter Maintenance

The SACS Letter Maintenance application makes it easy to add or edit your SACS Letters. You no longer need to remember the document names used by the SACS letter programs. The Letter Maintenance program will automatically load the correct document based on the letter that you select.

If you have never used this application, your system administrator will need to give you access. The application is located in the Productivity Tools module.
